

Forum Barcelona 2004 can be defined as a meeting point for the citizens of the world and a space for dialogue where the pressing issues of the 21st century can be debated.

Over the course of 141 days visitors will be able to immerse themselves in a multicultural environment that will encourage the renewal of attitudes and ideas. Forum Barcelona 2004 is being jointly organized by the Barcelona City Council, the Catalan Autonomous Government and the Spanish Government, and has the full support of UNESCO, whose 186 member states unanimously ratified their support for the Forum at the 29th General Conference.

Barcelona a city whose character encompasses both the quiet stroll around neighborhood streets and the cosmopolitan vibration of its inhabitants—provides an ideal setting for the celebration of a Universal Forum of Cultures. This summer presents a magnificent opportunity for people of all ages to come to Barcelona and be part of an event offering countless innovative proposals for the new century.

Over the 141 days that the event runs, the Forum will offer performance events in addition to those associated with Barcelona's regular summer festivals: Sonar, Grec and La Mercè), major exhibitionsin nearly all of the city's museums, and international conferences and debates. The length of the event and the diversity of its content will provide visitors with a wide variety of activities, allowing them to custom-design their own Forum experience.

The epicenter of this event will be located next to the Mediterranean Sea, at the end of Avinguda Diagonal. This area, located on the border between Barcelona and Sant Adrià de Besòs, is the extension of the waterfront and the culmination of a massive urban renewal project that began with the 1992 Olympic Games. The newly built Forum Site extends over thirty hectares, and is a perfect example of social and environmental development.



Three main themes define the Universal Forum of Cultures:

Cultural Diversity






