

Sanitation: The Most Difficult MDG to Meet
Description of event: <p>In some urban settlements, small, locally operated sanitation systems may be less expensive to construct and maintain than large, centralised systems: in most cases these systems play an integral role in provision of adequate sanitation and the MDG target. The objective of the dialogue is to create a platform to present these approaches and to promote “a learning by doing approach” so that effective small scale, community led sanitation initiatives can be replicated and upgraded, thus reaching a larger population and contributing to the MDG target.</p>
