UN-HABITAT LAUNCHES WEBSITE IN CHINESE

On World Habitat Day, UN-HABITAT will launch a Chinese language version of its website. The new website will enable the Chinese speaking audience to benefit from policies, case studies, best practices, guidelines and other information on sustainable urban development.

For China, a fast growing economy with a high rate of urbanization and a population which constitutes almost 20% of the world's population, sustainable urban development is an important issue. This is why UN-HABITAT is launching the Chinese language website to promote knowledge exchange, share the latest thinking on sustainable urbanization, and raise awareness of programmes in China and around the world that are working towards socially, economically and environmentally sustainable cities.

The new site is sponsored by Rizhao Municipality one of the 2009 winners of the UN-HABITAT Scroll of Honour award, the most prestigious United Nations human settlements award which recognizes outstanding contributions in shelter provision and improving the quality of urban life. Rizhao Municipality was awarded the Scroll for transforming the city into a green home with new housing and infrastructure.

The agency's outreach efforts to Chinese audiences also receives support from China's Ministry of Housing and Urban Rural Development which works closely with UN-HABITAT to promote sustainable urbanization in China and globally.
