AT THE HABITAT FORUM, CIVIL SOCIETY WAS GIVEN A PLACE OF RESPECT. GEORGEOUS CEDAR AMPHATHEATRES WERE BUILT BY THE YOUTH OF VANCOUVER. AND BY THE THOUSANDS, WE LISTENED AND LEARNED FROM GREAT INTELLECTUAL, SPIRITUAL AND ACTIVIST LEADERS OF THAT TIME. SOME DESCRIBED THIS AS THE WOODSTOCK FOR PLANNERS.

FOUR YEARS AGO, CANADA ASKED UN-HABITAT TO HOST WUF3. THIS IS THE FIRST WUF THAT IS A STAND ALONE EVENT FULLY HOSTED BY A NATION STATE. YOUR NEXT WUF4 WILL BE IN NANJING CHINA. PLEASE EXPERIENCE THIS AS BUT ONE STEP ON THE JOURNEY TO WORK TOGETHER ON THESE VITAL URBAN ISSUES.

I WANT TO RECOGNIZE AND THANK THE DEDICATED EFFORTS OF THE 17 DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES OF THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA, AND THE FEDERATION OF CANADIAN MUNIPALITIES, THAT HAVE WORKED WITH OUR SECRETARIAT IN OTTAWA AND COORDINATED OUR HOST RESPONSIBILITIES WITH A DEDICATED TEAM IN NAIROBI AT UN-HABITAT.

OUR THEMES AND SUBTHEMES REINFORCE THE MESSAGE THAT FOR ALL DECISIONS AT THE CITY LEVEL, WHETHER A SEWER, A ROAD OR A BUILDING, A PLAN MUST ADDRESS THE ECONOMIC, ENVIRONMENTAL AND SOCIAL DIMENSION IN AN INTEGRATED MANNER. THAT IS THE TRIPLE BOTTOM LINE, THE METRIC, THE ESSENTIAL DECISION MAKING PARADIGM.

ALL OF THIS HAS TO BE ACCOMPLISHED WITHIN A FOUNDATION OF GOOD GOVERNANCE, CIVIL AND PROPERTY RIGHTS AND WITH THE PUBLIC PARTICIPATION OF THOSE MOST AFFECTED BY THE DECISIONS.

OUR MEASURE OF SUCCESS THROUGHOUT THIS WEEK IS THAT YOU RETURN HOME TO YOUR COMMUNITIES WITH AT LEAST ONE ACTIONABLE IDEA.

THIRTY YEARS AGO, JANE JACOBS, IN ONE OF THOSE JERICHO BEACH HANGERS SHARED WITH US TWO LESSIONS. THE FIRST WAS THAT CITIES ARE ORGANIC. THEY GROW, THEY DECAY AND THEY ARE RENEWED AND REBORN. THE SECOND WAS A LESSON TAUGHT BY EXAMPLE, THAT THE CITIZENS MOST AFFECTED IN URBAN ISSUES MUST BE ENGAGED IN THE DECISION MAKING PROCESS. TODAY THE NEED FOR ENGAGEMENT OF THE POOR, THE WOMEN AND YOUTH IN ADDRESSING THE URBANIZATION OF OUR PLANET COULD NOT BE GREATER.

IN THIRTY YEARS WE HAVE LEARNED THAT NOT ONLY IS THE CITY ORGANIC, BUT THAT THE PLANET IS AN ORGANIC WHOLE....THAT DECISIONS MADE IN SHANGHAI AND MUMBAI HAVE ENVIRONMENTAL, ECONOMIC AND, YES INDEED, SOCIAL IMPACTS AROUND THE WORLD.

WE ARE ALL IN THIS TOGETHER AS GLOBAL CITIZENS.
