IESCO REPORTS: Dr. Anna Kajumulo Tibaijuka, UN under secretary-general and executive director of UN-HABITAT, who had attended the opening ceremony of the 29th Olympic Games in Beijing, arrived at Beautiful Asian Garden on the morning of August 9 to inspect the work of International Eco-Safety Cooperative Organization (IESCO) and held a cordial conversation with Dr. Jiang Mingjun, Chairman of IESCO. As IESCO presidium members, Zhang Deguang, former Chinese vice foreign minister, first secretary-general of Shanghai Cooperation Organization and board chairman of Chinese Foundation of International Studies, and Li Jingjie, president of China Society of Russia, East European and Central Asia Studies also attended the talk.

Dr. Jiang Mingjun briefed Tibaijuka on what IESCO had done since its establishment, and gave special introduction to the work IESCO did in disaster relief and habitat rebuilding after the May 12th earthquake in Sichuan, in jointly launching the aid projects in China of building two international ecological cities with European Association of Mutual Assistance and Association for the Development of Social Habitat, and in working together with China Railway Group to build Juyuan into a new international city in Dujiangyan, Sichuan Province. Dr. Anna Tibaijuka pointed out that the new cities should be built in the standard of the Best Practices for Urban Management of UN-HABITAT and be made "best practices with certain international influences".

Dr. Anna Tibaijuka holds that there will be broader stage for IESCO as it involves in the work of international strategic level. The implementation of the above mentioned projects requires not only the instruction of the Best Practices for Urban Management, but also the best policy and especially best execution. UN-HABITAT could provide related ideas, concepts, techniques and management experience.

It is reported that Dr. Tibaijuka will stay in Beijing for two days after the ceremony to watch sports events and meet with Chen Yuan, president of China Development Bank to discuss about establishing new strategic partnership in promoting global housing financing. Afterwards, besides Sichuan, she will go to Nanjing and Shanghai. She will consult with the Nanjing municipal government about the 4th World Urban Forum held from November 3 to 6 in Nanjing and sign memorandum of understanding with Shanghai municipal government on behalf of UN-HABITAT. IESCO will organize the networking event themed “ecological safety and North/North Cooperation” at the 4th World Urban Forum,

Founded in February, 2006, IESCO is a global international organization initiated by related agencies of the United Nations (Registration Code: NO.2114, REF. CP/LIC/SO/19/33430). Its principal aims and goals are through cooperation among government institutions, social organizations, private business sectors and financial departments, to maintain international ecological safety, reduce natural disasters, handle ecological crises, cope with unexpected ecological disasters and gradually realize UN Millennium Goals of development #1 eliminate poverty, #7 protect the environment and #8 global cooperation for the harmonious development of economy, society and ecology. IESCO now has 73 member states.
