## NOMENCLATURE AND ORDER OF PRESENTATION

Tables A.1 to A.5 contain regional, income and development aggregates data. Tables B.1 to B.13 and C.1 to C.7 contain national- and city-level data, respectively. In these tables, the countries or areas are listed in English alphabetical order within the macro-regions of Africa, Asia, Europe, Latin America, Northern America and Oceania. Countries or area names are presented in the form commonly used within the United Nations Secretariat for statistical purposes. Due to space limitations, the short name is used – for example, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland is referred to as ‘United Kingdom’.

## DEFINITION OF TERMS

**Assault:** Physical attack against the body of another person, including battery but excluding indecent assault. Some criminal or penal codes distinguish between aggravated assault and simple assault, depending on the degree of resulting injury.

**Automobile theft:** The removal of a motor vehicle without the consent of the owner of the vehicle.

**Bribery:** Requesting and/or accepting material or personal benefits, or the promise thereof, in connection with the performance of a public function for an action that may or may not be a violation of law and/or promising as well as giving material or personal benefits to a public officer in exchange for a requested favor.

**Burglary:** Unlawful entry into someone else’s premises with the intention to commit a crime.

**Control of corruption:** The extent to which public power is exercised for private gain, including both petty and grand forms of corruption, as well as ‘capture’ of the state by elites and private interests.

**Drug-related crimes:** Intentional acts that involve the cultivation, production, manufacture, extraction, preparation, offering for sale, distribution, purchase, sale, delivery on any terms whatsoever, brokerage, dispatch, dispatch in transit, transport, importation, exportation and possession of internationally controlled drugs.

**Embezzlement:** The wrongful appropriation of another person’s property that is already in the possession of the person doing the appropriating.

**Expenditure on health:** This covers expenditure on health services (preventive and curative), family planning activities, nutrition activities and emergency aid designated for health, but does not include provision of water and sanitation.

**Fraud:** The acquisition of another person’s property by deception.

**Gini index:** This measures the extent to which the distribution of income (or, in some cases, consumption expenditure) among individuals or households within an economy deviates from a perfectly equal distribution. A Lorenz curve plots the cumulative percentages of total income received against the cumulative number of recipients, starting with the poorest individual or household. The Gini index measures the area between the Lorenz curve and a hypothetical line of absolute equality, expressed as a percentage of the maximum area under the line. Thus, a Gini index of 0 represents perfect equality, while an index of 100 implies absolute inequality.

**Government effectiveness:** The quality of public services, the quality of the civil service and the degree of its independence from political pressures, the quality of policy formulation and implementation, and the credibility of the government’s commitment to such policies.

**GNI per capita (PPP):** This is gross national income divided by midyear population and converted to international dollars using purchasing power parity rates.

**Hospital beds:** Include inpatient beds available in public, private, general, and specialized hospitals and rehabilitation centres. In most cases, beds for both acute and chronic care are included.

**Household:** The concept of household is based on the arrangements made by persons, individually or in groups, for providing themselves with food or other essentials for living. A household may be either:

- A one-person household – that is to say, a person who makes provision for his or her own food or other essentials for living without combining with any other person to form a part of a multiperson household; or
- A multiperson household – that is to say, a group of two or more persons living together who make common provision for food or other essentials for living. The persons in the group may pool their incomes and may, to a greater or lesser extent, have a common budget; they may be related or unrelated persons or constitute a combination of persons both related and unrelated. This concept of household is known as the ‘housekeeping’ concept. It does not assume that the number of households and housing units is equal. Although the concept of housing unit implies that it is a space occupied by one household, it may also be occupied by more than one household or by a part of a household (for example, two nuclear households that share one housing unit for economic reasons or one household in a polygamous society routinely occupying two or more housing units).

**Improved drinking water coverage:** This is an indicator expressed as the percentage of people using improved drink-

ing water sources or delivery points (listed below). Improved drinking water technologies are more likely to provide safe drinking water than those characterized as unimproved. Improved drinking water sources: Piped water into dwelling, plot or yard; Public tap/standpipe; Tubewell/borehole; Protected dug well; Protected spring; Rainwater collection. Unimproved drinking water sources: Unprotected dug well; Unprotected spring; Cart with small tank/drum; Bottled water<sup>8</sup>; Tanker-truck; Surface water (river, dam, lake, pond, stream, canal, irrigation channels)

**Improved sanitation coverage:** This is an indicator expressed as the percentage of people using improved sanitation facilities (listed below). Improved sanitation facilities are more likely to prevent human contact with human excreta than unimproved facilities. Improved sanitation facilities: Flush or pour-flush to: piped sewer system, septic tank, pit latrine; Ventilated improved pit latrine; Pit latrine with slab; Composting toilet. Unimproved sanitation facilities: Flush or pour-flush to elsewhere<sup>9</sup>; Pit latrine without slab or open pit; Bucket; Hanging toilet or hanging latrine; No facilities or bush or field.

**Intentional homicide:** Death deliberately inflicted on a person by another person, including infanticide.

**Land inequality:** This measures the extent to which the distribution of land among individuals or households within an economy deviates from a perfectly equal distribution.

**Level of urbanization:** Percentage of the population residing in places classified as urban. Urban and rural settlements are defined in the national context and vary among countries (the definitions of urban are generally national definitions incorporated within the latest census).

**Life expectancy at birth:** Number of years a newborn infant would live if prevailing patterns of mortality at the time of birth were to stay the same throughout the child's life.

**Motor vehicles:** Include cars, buses and freight vehicles but not two-wheelers. Roads refer to motorways, highways, main or national roads, and secondary or regional roads. A motorway is a road specially designed and built for motor traffic that separates the traffic flowing in opposite directions.

**Natural Disaster:** A serious disruption triggered by a natural hazard causing human, material, economic or environmental losses, which exceed the ability of those affected to cope.

**Natural Hazard:** Natural processes or phenomena occurring in the biosphere that may constitute a damaging event. Hazardous events vary in magnitude, frequency, duration, area of extent, speed of onset, spatial dispersion and temporal spacing. In tables, natural hazards refer exclusively to earthquake, tropical cyclone, flood and drought.

**Non-intentional homicide:** Death not deliberately inflicted on a person by another person. This includes the crime of manslaughter but excludes traffic accidents that result in the death of persons.

**Persons in housing units:** Number of persons resident in housing units.

**Persons prosecuted:** Alleged offenders prosecuted by means of an official charge, initiated by the public prosecutor or the law enforcement agency responsible for prosecution.

**Police staff:** Police personnel or law enforcement personnel in public agencies whose principal functions are the prevention, detection and investigation of crime and the apprehension of alleged offenders. Data concerning support staff (secretaries, clerks etc.) are not excluded.

**Political stability and absence of violence:** Perceptions of the likelihood that the government will be destabilized or overthrown by unconstitutional or violent means, including domestic violence and terrorism.

**Poor households:** Percentage of women and men-headed households situated below the locally defined poverty line. The poverty line is usually an 'absolute' poverty line, taken as the income necessary to afford a minimum nutritionally adequate diet, plus essential non-food requirements, for a household of a given size.

**Population, total:** Mid-year population estimates for the world, region, countries or areas. The Population Division of the United Nations Department of Economic and Social Affairs updates, every two years, population estimates and projections by incorporating new data, new estimates and new analyses of data on population, fertility, mortality and international migration. Data from new population censuses and/or demographic surveys are used to verify and update old estimates of population or demographic indicators, or to make new ones and to check the validity of the assumptions made in the projections. Total population refers to the estimates and projections (medium variant) of the total population for each country region and major area. Annual growth rate, calculated by UN-Habitat, refers to the average annual percentage change of population during the indicated period for each country, major regions and global totals. The formula used throughout the Annex is as follows:  $r = [(1/t) \times \ln(A2/A1)] \times 100$ , where 'A1' is a value at any given year; 'A2' is a value at any given year later than the year of 'A1'; 't' is the year interval between 'A1' and 'A2'; and 'ln' is the natural logarithm function.

**Population affected by conflicts:** This refers to percentage of total population affected by armed conflicts. **Armed conflict:** A contested incompatibility that concerns government and/or territory where the use of armed force between two parties, of which at least one is the government of a state, results in at least 25 battle related deaths.

**Population, urban and rural:** Mid-year estimates and projections (medium variant) of the population residing in human settlements classified as urban or rural.

**Poverty definitions:** *National poverty rate:* Percentage of the population living below the national poverty line. National estimates are based on population-weighted subgroup estimates from household surveys. Survey year is the year in which the underlying data were collected. *Population below US\$1 a day and Population below US\$2 a day:* Percentages of the population living on less than US\$1.08 a day and US\$2.15 a day at 1993 international prices (equivalent to US\$1 and US\$2 in 1985 prices, adjusted for purchasing power parity).

**Prevalence of HIV, 15-49 age group:** The percentage of population aged 15-49 years who are infected with HIV.

**Prosecution staff:** Prosecution personnel - a government official whose duty is to initiate and maintain criminal proceedings on behalf of the state against persons accused of committing a criminal offence. In some countries, a prosecutor is a member of a separate agency, in others, a prosecutor is a member of the police or judiciary.

**Rape:** Sexual intercourse without valid consent by one of the parties involved.

**Refugees, asylum-seekers and others concern:** Data are provided by governments based on their own definitions and methods of collection. Total asylum-seekers, refugees and others of concern to the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) include the following. *Refugees:* Persons recognized as refugees under the international conventions, in accordance with the UNHCR Statute; persons allowed to stay on humanitarian grounds and those granted temporary protection. *Asylum-seekers:* Persons whose application for refugee status is pending in the asylum procedure or who are otherwise registered as asylum-seekers. The total number of asylum-seekers is underestimated due to a lack of data from a number of countries. *Returned refugees:* Refugees who have returned to their country of origin during the year. *Internally displaced persons (IDPs):* Persons who are displaced within their country and to whom UNHCR extends protection or assistance, generally pursuant to a special request by a competent organ of the United Nations. *Returned IDPs:* IDPs of concern to UNHCR who have returned to their place of origin during the year. *Stateless Person:* Any person who is not considered as a national by any state through its nationality legislation or constitution. This definition refers mainly to *de jure* stateless persons but also includes *de facto* stateless persons as well as persons who have difficulties establishing their nationality. Refugees and asylum seekers by place of origin excludes stateless persons.

**Regulatory quality:** The ability of the government to formulate and implement sound policies and regulations that permit and promote private sector development.

**Roads:** Motorways, highways, main or national roads, and secondary or regional roads. A motorway is a road specially designed and built for motor vehicles that separates the traffic flowing in opposite directions. *Total road network:* Includes motorways, highways and main or national roads, secondary or regional roads, and all other roads in a country. *Paved roads:* Roads surfaced with crushed stone (macadam) and hydrocarbon binder or bitumized agents, with concrete or with cobblestones, as a percentage of all of the country's roads measured in length.

**Robbery:** The theft of property from a person, overcoming resistance by force or threat of force.

**Rule of law:** The extent to which agents have confidence in and abide by the rules of society, and in particular the quality of contract enforcement, the police, and the courts, as well as the likelihood of crime and violence.

**Slum dwellers:** Individuals residing in housing with one or more of the following conditions: inadequate drinking water; inadequate sanitation; poor structural quality/durability of housing; overcrowding; and insecurity of tenure.

**Theft:** The removal of property without the property owner's consent. Theft excludes burglary and housebreaking as well as theft of a motor vehicle. Some criminal and penal codes distinguish between grand and petty theft, depending on the value of the goods and property taken from their rightful owner.

**Transport used for work trips:** Percentage of work trips undertaken by private car; train, tram or ferry; bus or minibus; other (motorcycle, bicycle and other non-motorized modes). When several modes of transport are used for a given trip, the principal mode is selected.

**Travel time:** Average time in minutes for a one-way work trip. This is an average over all modes of transport.

**Urban agglomerations and capital cities:** The term 'urban agglomeration' refers to the population contained within the contours of a contiguous territory inhabited at urban density levels without regard to administrative boundaries. It usually incorporates the population in a city or town plus that in the suburban areas lying outside of but being adjacent to the city boundaries. Whenever possible, data classified according to the concept of urban agglomeration are used. However, some countries do not produce data according to the concept of urban agglomeration but use instead that of metropolitan area or city proper. If possible, such data are adjusted to conform to the concept of urban agglomeration. When sufficient information is not available to permit such an adjustment, data based on the concept of city proper or metropolitan area are used. The sources listed online indicate whether data were adjusted to conform to the urban agglomeration concept or whether a different concept was used. Table C.1 contains revised estimates and projections for all urban agglomerations comprising 750,000 or more inhabitants.

**Urban population:** This is the midyear population of areas defined as urban in each country and reported to the United Nations. Estimates of the world's urban population would change significantly if China, India, and a few other populous nations were to change their definition of urban centers. According to China's State Statistical Bureau, by the end of 1996 urban residents accounted for about 43 percent of China's population, while in 1994 only 20 percent of the population was considered urban. In addition to the continuous migration of people from rural to urban areas, one of the main reasons for this shift was the rapid growth in the hundreds of towns reclassified as cities in recent years. Because the estimates in the table are based on national definitions of what constitutes a city or metropolitan area, cross-country comparisons should be made with caution.

**Voice and accountability:** The extent to which a country's citizens are able to participate in selecting their government, as well as freedom of expression, freedom of association, and a free media.

**Wastewater treated:** Percentage of all wastewater undergoing some form of treatment.

**Water consumption:** Average consumption of water in litres per day per person for all domestic uses (excludes industrial use) in settlements.

**Water supply system:** 'Housing units with piped water inside the housing unit' refers to the existence of water pipes within the walls that constitute a housing unit. Water can be piped from a community source – that is, one that is subject to inspection and control by public authorities. Water can also be piped into the unit from a private source, such as a pressure tank, a pump or some other installation. The category 'piped water outside unit, but within 200 metres' refers to units where the piped water is not available to occupants within the unit they reside in, but is accessible within the range of 200 metres, assuming that access to piped water within that distance allows occupants to provide water for household needs without being subjected to extreme effort. 'Other' refers to units that do not have access to piped water at all, whose occupants depend upon springs or wells, or to units where piped water is located beyond 200 metres.

As of 31 May 2002, Estonia and Kiribati were not members of any regional group. By General Assembly Resolution 52/250 (1998), the General Assembly conferred upon Palestine, in its capacity as observer, additional rights and privileges of participation. These included, *inter alia*, the right to participation in the general debate of the General Assembly, but did not include the right to vote or to put forward candidates.
