



#### The Web of Institutionalisation







95 % of all villages are covered, the rest represented by 5% will be covered by 2007.



#### Water and Sanitation: Key Challenges

- 1. Institutional Challenges
- 2. Linking supply to demand
- 3. Outdated Tariff Structure (cost recovery of service provision)
- 4. Lack of Managerial skills at both macro and micro levels.
- 5. Limited / partial central government awareness about low cost options especially in Sanitation
