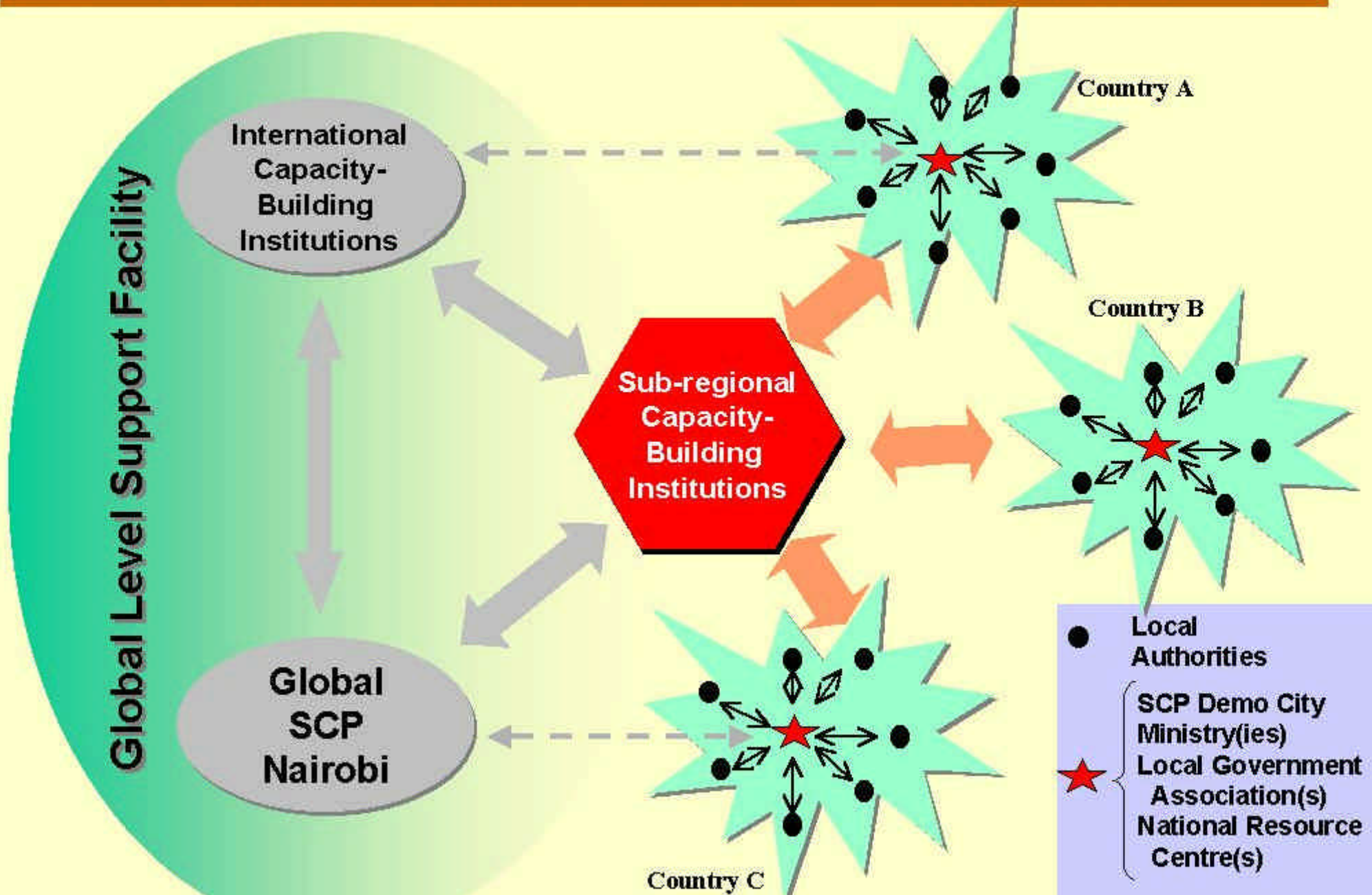

Status

- Documented lessons of experience in Sri Lanka and Nigeria
- Capacity Building Strategy for Sri Lanka was prepared
- Anchoring Institutes selected for South East Asia
- Induction course for SEA held in Thailand
- Havana 2005: recommendations for CB strategy

Findings

- No structured approach or strategy at the start of the programme.
- Frequent change of personalities at target level needs repetitive training and awareness (and resources)
- No follow-up and monitoring
- Existing tools have limited impact
- No attention to behavioral and contextual change
- How to make training more attractive (incentives and mode of training)
